```
print 25 * 1.2
```

Calculator

- 1 Input: initial amount and the tip percentage.
- 2 Output: final amount.

- 1 Input: initial amount and service quality.
- 2 Output: final amount.

Conditionals

```
if <condition>:  
    <statement 1>  
    <statement 2>  
else:  
    <statement 3>
```

Lists

```
students = ['Luis', 'Mark', 'Rita']
```

```
print students[0]
```

```
print students[1]
```

```
print students[2]
```

Loops

```
students = ['Luis', 'Mark', 'Rita', ...]
```

```
for st in students:  
    print st
```

Loops (II)

```
students = ['Luis',...]  
  
looking_for = 'Anna'  
  
i = 0  
while students[i] != looking_for:  
    i += 1  
  
if students[i] == looking_for:  
    print 'Found her'  
else:  
    print "Sorry, she's not registered!"
```
